Dear Alumni, Family, and Friends of Princeton Sailing,


This past year has been incredibly successful for our team, both on and off the water. I am so proud of my teammates and all they have accomplished. This past year, our team attended 22 regattas, the most in recent history, across the co-ed dinghy, women's, single-handed, and keelboat classes. We made it to our first women's conference championship in 15 years and our co-ed conference championship for the first time in a decade. Connor Mraz '23 captured 2 A-fleet wins, ending a nearly 3 year drought, and we ended our historic season with an overall win at the Engineer's Cup with a group of entirely first-years. We finished the season ranked 46th in the nation, and we are prepared to make a bid for Nationals (top 36) next year.

While the competitive results speak for themselves, I am most proud of the way this team has come together off the water. Nothing has made me happier than watching our team become a true group of friends. We are cohesive, focused, supportive, and enthusiastic - all qualities which improve results on the water. Every single member of this team contributes something unique and indispensable to the dyanmics of the group, building a culture that is welcoming, fun, and competitive. I feel so lucky to be a part of it.

On that note, I must especially thank the graduating Class of 2022, the class with which I entered Princeton, for their leadership in shaping the culture of our team. It has been such a pleasure spending the past 4 years on this team with you. It is inspiring watching you grow from the freshman peers I once knew into the upperclassman leaders you all have become. It is evident that the underclassmen on the team not only look up to you but appreciate your genuine friendship. Your presence on this team will be sorely missed, but I cannot wait to see what amazing things you do next.

I enjoyed seeing so many alumni and friends at our Reunions reception. While we celebrate our successes, it is important to recognize the rich legacy from which we build. It is comforting to see that the bonds and friendships made on the Princeton Sailing Team truly do last a lifetime.

The Princeton Tigers had an incredible Spring season. Following a successful Fall, the season began in January with an unofficial training trip to Sarasota, Florida. March

On our first regatta weekend of the season, March 5-6, the team sailed in two regattas. The Tigers at the Tom Noble Team Race represented the classes of '22, '23, '24, and '25 and came in 2nd place. At the Eckerd Interconference, Connor Mraz'23, Nelson Chow'23, Asher Green '24, and Anna Eaton '24 competed against various SAISA teams in Florida.

This event was valuable practice for the Hanbury Trophy the following weekend, where harsh winds shortened the first day of racing. Connor Mraz '23 and Nelson Chow'23 led Princeton to its first A-division win in nearly 3 years!

The squad came in 5th place out of 8.

Our Spring Season was highlighted by the busy weekend of April 16-17, when the Tigers competed in 3 separate regattas. Skipper **Jasper Waldman '25** and crew **Eddie O'Keefe '25** sailed in A-Fleet at the Owen Trophy. The Owen Trophy was a one-day event at Kings Point, NY, and after completing the event, B-fleet sailors **Robert Rubin '23** and **Chai Mauliola '24** joined the squad in Chestertown, MD at the Grant Trophy.

In a historic result, the Tigers won the Grant Trophy, securing a spot in the conference championship, the America Trophy, for the first time in a decade. Connor Mraz '23 and Aliya Ismagilova '22 won A-fleet. The Tigers were 2 points down with one set left, and B-fleet sailors Asher Green '24 and Anna Eaton '24 sailed a nail-biting final set to secure the overall win.


Aliya Ismagilova
